



DO'S

- Ensure proper earthing as per the recommended installation requirements.
- Keep the battery away from heat and water sources and protect it from moisture.
- Keep the battery and its cables in good condition before operation.
- In case of contact with any battery substance, rinse the affected skin or eyes immediately with clean water and seek medical advice.

DON'Ts

- Do not connect the battery earthing to house wiring if this may void the warranty.
- Do not disassemble, reassemble, or repair the battery. Improper reassembly may cause combustion or electric shock.
- Do not use the battery near heat or water sources or allow it to become wet.
- Do not insert nails or other objects into the battery, strike it, or weld directly on the battery.
- Do not use a badly damaged battery or operate it with damaged cables.
- Do not freeze the battery.
- Do not use the battery if it is damaged, waterlogged, distorted, or broken.
